



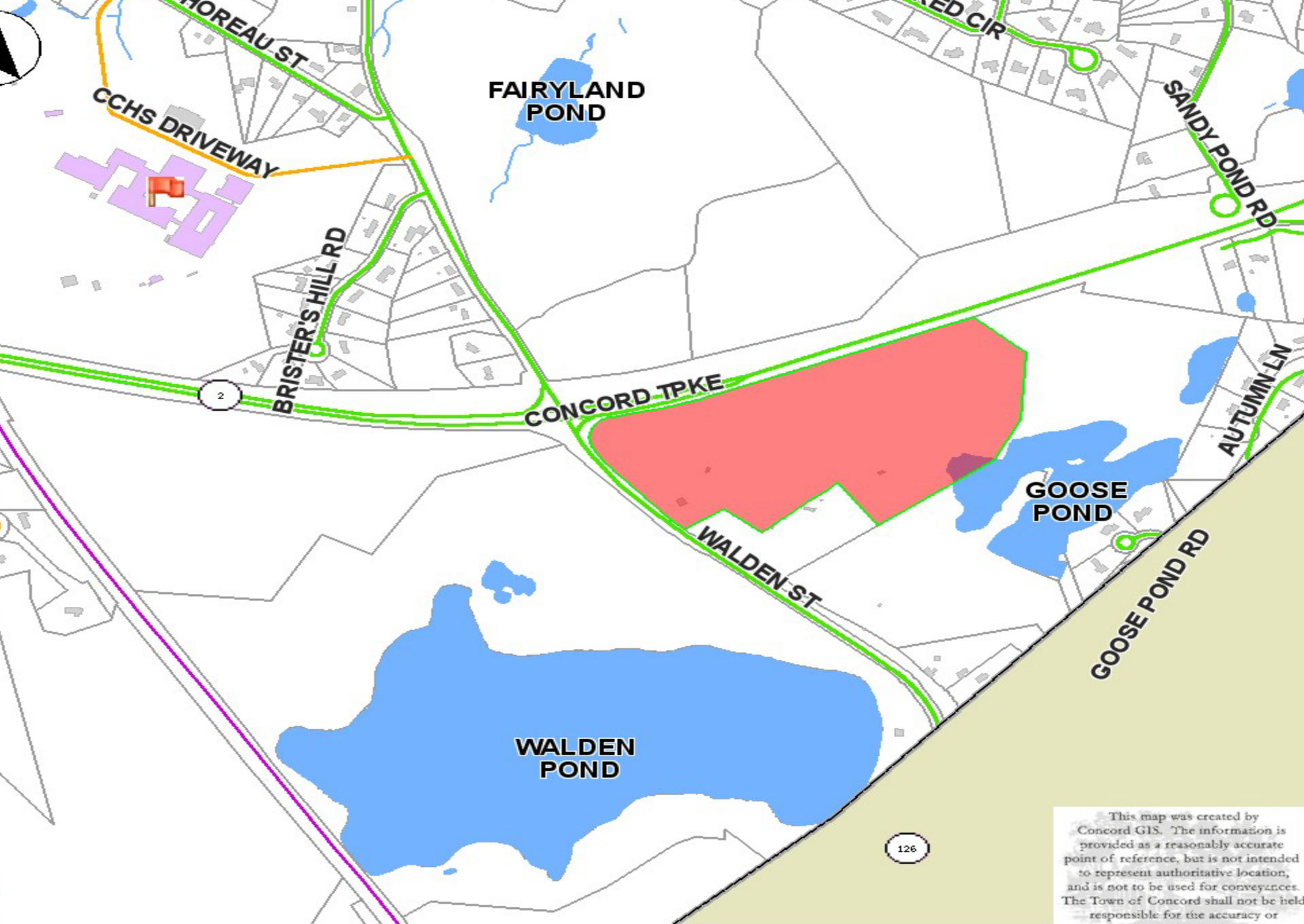

Article 12 – Sale of Conservation Restriction on former Landfill Site

ARTICLE 12. To determine whether the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to convey to Walden Woods Project, a not-for-profit organization, or to a similar conservation organization, a conservation restriction pursuant to Chapter 184, §§ 31-33 of the Massachusetts General Laws, on terms and conditions agreeable to the Selectmen, on all or a portion of the parcel of land at 759 Walden Street identified on the Assessor's maps as parcel #4039, comprised of approximately 35.4 acres, said conservation restriction to permit the Town to carry out solar energy generation and public works activities on the site, and further to authorize the Selectmen to accept the sum of \$2.8 million or any other sum as compensation for the conservation restriction, or take any other action relative thereto.



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
